#### Reminder of PSIA Operating Policy

##### *Antitrust*

The discussion should not address market allocation, pricing, or similar anticompetitive matters.

##### *Intellectual Property*

If a participant knows his or her company has patent claims that cover a portion of the spec or standard under discussion, he or she is obligated to disclose those claims, and the company must either agree to negotiate RAND (Reasonable and Non-Discriminatory) license terms or the WG will have to try to work around the claims (and the company may be asked not to participate further if this happens repeatedly).

  - ii. For a PACS vendor
    1. Where can I find out more technical detail about PLAI?
    2. What do I need to do to start implementing a PLAI adaptor within my PACS system?
    3. Is there an implementation guide for completing the PLAI adaptor?
    4. Where can I get access to the PLAI agent?
    5. What sort of test tools are available?
    6. How long does the implementation normally take? For a test system? To be production ready?
    7. What sort of licensing is involved in having the existing PLAI agent available?
    8. In a multiple PACS customer scenario, who provides and owns the agent?
    9. Can I or do I have to create our own PLAI agent?
    10. What is the business proposition for my company? Sell the PLAI agent, sell a PLAI adaptor component?
    11. Will customers be demanding that I am PLAI compliant?
    12. Why would I do this when it seems to dilute my opportunity to expand my PACS within customer sites?
  - iii. For a consultant
    1. Is there a PLAI specification available that I can use for my documentation/specification use?
    2. What business value am I going to espouse to customers for adopting PLAI compliant PACS and this architecture?
    3. When will this be available?
    4. Where can I find out/read more?

### Discussion:

- Meeting opened at 5pm EST
- There was no implementation guide update with Gallagher not on today's call
- Plugfest concept was discussed briefly – to be discussed further
- Jeffrey Longo provided an online demonstration of the Test Tools with a number of questions answered. The groups thanks to Jeff for that demonstration.
- PLAI website – work still required on this (Darren, Dave and Debbie to progress)
- The main topic of conversation was around what we will be presenting at ASIS
  - An overview of the questions provided in the agenda was discussed
  - Brad put forward the suggestion that we also take a step back at the start of a PLAI presentation to echo what the motivations of PSIA are, before diving into the PLAI detail. This was discussed and agreed on.
    - Standardization of configuration
    - Standardization of the commissioning of devices
    - Standardization of the issuance of credentials
    - Standardization of installation and deployment of physical security systems
    - Physical/logical convergence
    - Etc.
  - It was also agreed to put the questions and presentation overview into a collaborative document with different sub-groups of PLAI representatives being asked to provide first draft answers on these. This document is being compiled and will be distributed shortly.
  - It was agreed that a formal presentation should be completed at ASIS - what facilities/rooms/resources will we have available for the presentation at ASIS – bookings need to be made
