Antitrust

The discussion should not address market allocation, pricing, or similar anticompetitive matters.

Intellectual Property

If a participant knows his or her company has patent claims that cover a portion of the spec or standard under discussion, he or she is obligated to disclose those claims, and the company must either agree to negotiate RAND (Reasonable and Non-Discriminatory) license terms or the WG will have to try to work around the claims (and the company may be asked not to participate further if this happens repeatedly).

Discussion:

- Meeting opened at 5:03pm EST
- The minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed and the outstanding activities were discussed
 - Conformant products – Dave Bunzel – still a work in progress
 - PACS for demonstration
 - Honeywell – no further progress as yet
 - Lenel – Dave discussed this with Ewa and she advised they would support demonstrating what they had last time (and will allow Yuri



to give some time to this) but had no resources to expand it to support the Location or Zone Awareness capabilities. Darren discussed with Jeff if it was possible to get a short document to them which outlined the level of changes required (estimated at less than a week) so that they did not need to dig into this (which could be viewed and something that might take longer than a week). Darren to progress getting this level of detail to them with Jeff (Darren on leave next week)

- Stanley – ongoing discussions
- HID – Darren and Dave spoke with Dave Adams from HID last week and he committed to providing a draft matrix of how he understood their mobile capabilities vs what PLAI functionality was and then we will review that provide updates as needed. This exercise should reveal to HID what the level of effort and details of the engineering activities would be and Dave should then be able to better quantify and seek resources for making this happen – if this is possible then it is likely to be for an ASIS timeline and not for ISC West at this stage
- Mercury – Dave organized for Michael Serrafin from Mercury to join the call and provide details of their BACnet capabilities. He described how they have boards that have I/O on them for interfacing over BACnet. Dave asked if this might fit into our PLAI demonstration in any meaningful way. Darren initially felt that with a PACS reader connected to a Mercury board and then potentially with I/O for BACnet this was kind of a hardware approach to what the east bound interface processes in PLAI were doing. However Jeff advised that BACnet does not support GUIDs and that since PLAI is pretty heavily dependent on GUIDs this was an issue as there needed to be a way to cross-reference the PACS data to make it meaningful for the BACnet interface. This will require further discussion (see relevant translation points on Tridium below)
- Jeff reiterated that Kastle want to have PACS vendors supporting the ISC West demo as a part of their efforts to complete the Tridium interface – efforts will continue to make that the case
- Darren read out a draft of the PLAI demonstration copy for the PSIA website (save the date) – this is provided below and needs to be reviewed and finalized (Shayne to take point on that please)
 - The PSIA will be demonstrating advanced new features of the PLAI architecture that facilitate PACS interacting with authoritative identity source, IoT devices and other systems. Microsoft will also be announcing and illustrating how they are leveraging PLAI.
- Dave has completed formatting the CMEM specification changes and these are awaiting finalization
- ISC West Demonstration
 - Confirmed that Kastle are finalizing support from the Kastle PLAI adapter and the PLAI agent for the location/zone awareness (eastbound interface) work required for the demonstration
 - Kastle are also going to be completing the PLAI Adapter to cater for the interface to Tridium – this will convert the PLAI data to what is required for the BACnet operations. Jeff will follow up with Laura in the coming weeks to progress that



- Laura confirmed that Tridium can provide the hardware piece for the demonstration at ISC West to allow it to be the east bound system and have visual changes occur due to badge reads
- Darren advised that PLAI discussions and activities with Microsoft continue to progress well and that the ISC West Demonstration for this would be ready on time
- Meeting closed at 5:48pm EST
