Letter from the Executive Director

As we approach the end of the calendar year, we reflect on the significant progress made by PSIA. In addition to our camera spec (IPMD), we released a storage spec (Recording and Content Management: RaCM) and a video analytics spec (VAS). To complement these we introduced test tools for the IPMD spec and the RaCM spec and a conformance plan for VMS vendors. We have also released the Common Metadata and Events Model (CMEM), a critical component to allow the devices to communicate with each other. We have seen strong growth in companies that have downloaded the specs, implemented them into products, and gone through the conformance plans. This is affirmation that the industry understands the benefits of products that follow common specifications to achieve interoperability.
