

The Physical Security Interoperability Alliance (PSIA) Hosts Virtual PSIA Experience at GSX 2022


PLAI and PKOC Specifications Demonstrated



(Santa Clara, CA –September 27, 2022) The Physical Security Interoperability Alliance hosted a successful event, the PSIA Experience, at GSX 2022 in Atlanta. The PSIA Experience featured an interactive demo of physical access control system (PACS) and credential interoperability, offered in real-time on the GSX expo floor.

Security industry professionals were able to experience first-hand the simpler access control environments that the PLAI (Physical Logical Access Interoperability) and PKOC (Public Key Open Credential) specifications provide.

Participants in the PSIA Experience were able to enroll in advance or at the show, receive an access card and badge-in or authenticate at four different stands. Additional partners showing PKOC and biometrics were also at some of these stands, bringing total participants up to 11! Companies participating included AMAG, Advancis (Cruatech), Convergint, Elatec, Idemia, Johnson Controls, Last Lock, Monitor Dynamics, RealNetworks (SAFR Scan), Sentry Card, and rf IDEAS. Interoperability, real-time sharing of identity information, and a cloudbased system were all included in the demonstration.
